In support initially of Operation Desert Spring and then Operation Iraqi Freedom from October 2002 through July 2003, Sergeant Major Kevin Gainey was the analysis and control element (ACE) noncommissioned officer in charge for the 3rd Infantry Division out of Fort Stewart, Georgia. His division intelligence support element represented a major portion of his ACE that was supporting the 2nd Brigade Combat Team for the 3rd Infantry Division, and was responsible for compiling and generating collected intelligence for reporting or follow-on actions for the entire country of Iraq. A major challenge for him was going from being trained to fight a conventional war and analyze intelligence in that manner and then immediately into a stability and support operations environment that

they weren't prepared to do. He also implies that evidence of weapons of mass destruction were found but does not elaborate. Following the ground war, the ACE was moved to Baghdad International Airport. From here Gainey touches on the challenge of identifying the political power structures that exist in Iraq. Part of the intelligence analysis performed included a review of certain personalities or groups. It was a challenge to try to determine political or tribal allegiances and if someone was therefore trustworthy or corrupt. Then, he had to determine if they were getting outside support from another country and, if so, whether it was Iran, Syria or elsewhere. His team would build target folders and provide that to stakeholders who actually needed the information to help them make those decisions on who they could deal with and who they couldn't trust. Gainey is very confident in what he knew about Iraqi culture and religion before the war and thereafter with no recognized need for him to learn more. He also shares his frustration with media reporting in Iraq and discusses his experiences with high-value targets, the operational plan for the ground war

and anticipated reactions to problems. Finally, Gainey explains that we need to be more prepared to go from Phase III to Phase IV next time and will be because we have lessons learned from this experience.

Major Tony Gainey deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom in May 2005 as part

of a military transition team (MiTT) assigned to coach, teach and mentor the 2nd Brigade of the 2nd Iraqi Army Division: a Kurd and Sunni-Arab mixed unit based at Al Kindi. He discusses his predeployment training at Fort Carson as well as his in-theater training in Kuwait and at the Phoenix Academy in Taji, Iraq. In addition, Gainey talks about his dual role as the assistant operations officer trainer and the primary personnel officer trainer for the Iraqi brigade, working closely with the Iraqi G1, who was his direct counterpart. Gainey's MiTT focused chiefly on command and control and staff planning functions, things in which he said the brigade showed marked improvement over his time there, even though they weren't yet ready to perform completely on their own. Said Gainey of the Iraqi brigade's working of the full range of personnel/administrative tasks, and which represented an ongoing challenge: "What I learned while I was there was that they didn't see administrative functions as a macho thing, so they tended to sweep it aside. Admin stuff was for wimps, which is probably why they had so many issues with pay. It wasn't high on their list of things to do because it was an administrative function. Tracking personnel wasn't a high priority. Administrative things were not macho in their eyes, and being macho was important."

Paleoindian toolkits represent successful adaptations to the unique and varying environments that existed in North America at the end of the Wisconsin glacial period. Because such adaptations were ecologically influenced, different emphases appear in toolkits throughout the continent which provide insight into the lives of these people. Compared to sites in western North America, sites in the eastern woodlands demonstrate a dramatic increase in the amounts of stone end scrapers that have been recovered from Paleoindian contexts. This disparity points to the fact that the activity or activities associated with these tools became more adaptively significant. Nobles Pond, a Gainey phase (ca. 11,200 BP) Paleoindian site in northeastern Ohio, contains the largest collection of end scrapers recovered to date. This assemblage represents a unique opportunity to systematically study the morphological characteristics of these tools to create a general use-life of end-scrapers in an eastern Paleo-Indian context. Detailed observation of features such as form, size, and symmetry will help outline a sequence of production, use, and depletion. This use-life model helps

support the conclusion that Paleoindian end scrapers were functionally redundant; the variation exhibited by this class of tools is seen as a result of extensive retouch and depletion.
