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Anticipation Guide | Classroom Strategies | Reading Rockets

An anticipation guide is a comprehension strategy that is used before reading to activate students' prior knowledge and build curiosity about a new topic. Before reading, students listen to or read several statements about key concepts presented in the text; they're often structured as a series of statements with which the students can choose to agree or disagree.

Anticipation Guide - Comprehension Strategies

Choose the assigned reading and introduce the text to the students. Ask students read only the first line of the assigned text, or if using your read aloud, read aloud only the first line. Ask students to make predictions for the reading based on the first sentence. Engage the class in discussion about the predictions.

Prior to reading, students read a list of statements about a given topic and begin to make connections with a text they will soon read.

An anticipation guide is a strategy that is used before reading to activate students' prior knowledge and build curiosity about a new topic. Before reading a selection, students respond to several statements that challenge or support their preconceived ideas about key concepts in the text.

Anticipation Guide - Reading Strategies & Misconceptions

Reading guides can assist with developing students' comprehension. They help students navigate reading material, especially difficult chapters or nonfiction reading. Students respond to a teacher-created written guide of prompts as they read an assigned text.

Strategy 9 - Reading Comprehension Strategies

Anticipation Guide Before reading a fiction or non-fiction text, students discuss their ideas and points of view before reading the material. Students respond to a series of questions or statements about the topic.
