The result is a fascinatingly detailed revelation of the rise of this diabolical genius. Through Heydrich's racial campaigns, which gathered their own momentum after his death, six million Jews were murdered by 1945. And yet this son of a cultured, upper-middle-class Roman Catholic family, who became the real power behind Himmler, was himself blackmailed by the Führer for possessing non-Aryan blood. In addition to clarifying this aspect of Heydrich's astonishing career, the author throws new light, too, on “ Plan Ost ”, the blueprint for the extermination of thirty million Slavs, and on the mystery surrounding Heydrich's assassination in 1942. Here, then, is the full story of the man with the iron heart—Heydrich, Hitler's most evil henchman.
