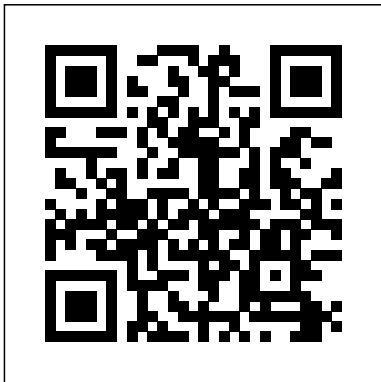

Excerpt from The Edinboro Quarterly, Vol. 9: July 1922 The Northwestern Pennsylvania electric railway passes the Normal School campus. This road provides excellent Service to Erie, twenty miles north, where it connects with the New York Central, the Pennsylvania, the Nickel Plate and the Bessemer roads. At Cambridge Springs, seven miles south of Edinboro, it connects with the Erie, and it connects with the Bessemer at

Harmonsburg and Linesville, and at the latter point also with the Pennsylvania. When coming through Erie one should deliver baggage checks to the Erie Transfer Company, which will transfer baggage to the Northwestern Pennsylvania station. On reaching the campus, the student should go at once to the administrative Offices in Normal Hall for registration.
