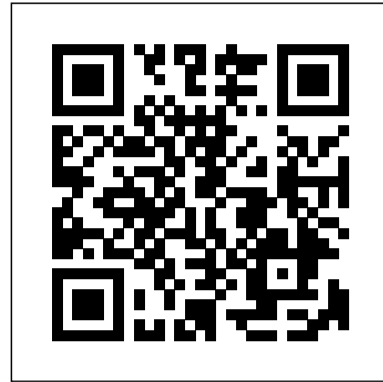


## School District
